

Comparison of Florida to National Responses on Hospital Satisfaction Survey

<i>Percent of patients who reported that:</i>	<i>U.S.</i>	<i>Florida</i>
Their nurses always communicated well	73%	66%
Their doctors always communicated well	79%	73%
They always received help as soon as they wanted	60%	52%
Their pain was always well controlled	67%	62%
Staff always explained about medicines before giving them	58%	51%
Their room and bathroom were always clean	68%	60%
The area around their room was always quiet at night	54%	49%
They were given information about what to do during their recovery at home	79%	74%
They would give their hospital a rating of 9 or 10 on a scale from 0 (lowest) to 10 (highest)	63%	56%
They would definitely recommend the hospital	67%	61%
